

have received appointments to various committees and commissions related to the sexual abuse and sexual compulsions of individuals.

4. I have evaluated and counseled victims of sexual trauma, assessed damages of abuse, and treated sexual offenders throughout my career.

5. I have testified as an expert or been qualified as an expert in the areas of sexual trauma and sexual compulsions and deviations in multiple jurisdictions, in both federal and state courts. I have provided testimony in civil and criminal trials.

6. I have taught classes and workshops in sexual trauma and compulsions at the undergraduate and graduate level for more than 25 years to more than 200,000 professionals including Catholic Vicars.

7. In addition to my own professional training and experience, I am knowledgeable about the professional literature in a number of fields insofar as it concerns sexual abuse by priests and other clergy, and its impact.

8. I have been employed by the firm of Betty, Neuman & McMahon, L.L.P., counsel to the Plaintiff in this case, to examine the facts and provide expert opinion. The opinions which follow are based on my professional training, knowledge, experience, a psychological interview with James Wells, psychological testing of James Wells, as well as a review of his mental health records.

9. My opinions assume that the Plaintiff was a minor child at the time of all perpetrations of sexual abuse, which occurred in the 1950s and early 1960s.

10. It is my professional opinion, to a reasonable degree of psychological certainty, that the Plaintiff in this case sustained considerable damages as a result of the sexual trauma perpetrated by Father Janssen. On a scale of one to ten, I would rate the damages sustained by the Plaintiff as a nine.

11. Mr. Wells stated that the memories of the abuse began at age five. Father Janssen was visiting his family's home in Chicago for Thanksgiving. The priest "took a nap" and the boy went with him. He stuck his hands down his pants and the boy was "scared and frightened." His family moved to Davenport in 1958. Mr. Wells had multiple perpetrations by Father Janssen in the priest's car, as well as the rectory on a two to three times a week basis until he was age 13 or 14. This included masturbating, fondling, and the priest masturbating and also includes on occasions with other boys in the car. Janssen would stop on an isolated dirt road and fondle and masturbate the boy. The molestation in the car was on many occasions but one that he vividly remembers is the trip to Fort Lauderdale, when he stopped in Memphis to pick up Father Murphy. Father Janssen offered the boy to Father Murphy as a sexual companion, but the boy refused. He also remembers sex with Janssen in the swimming pool at Fort Madison, the River View Amusement Park, the Lend-A-Hand pool and in the garage attic of his house. Each of these locations are specifically described by the client and several of the same locations have been noted by the other victims independently. He states that one of the reasons he cooperated was to keep his brother from being molested. He threatened that he would tell if the priest molested his brother. In spite of this, Janssen also abused his brother.

12. Mr. Wells reports that he has been diagnosed in 2000 as manic-depressive and medicated with specific drugs to control the mood swings. He had prior psychiatric evaluations in 1998, 1990, 1986, 1985 and has likely been psychiatrically impaired throughout this period. He reports nightmares and flashbacks in the depressive phase. He would self-medicate with alcohol and marijuana until he was given Effexor and Remeron, these medications have helped him tremendously. Currently, he lives in the moment and has difficulty planning for the future. In the manic phase, he reports wild excesses, for example: gambling binges in Las Vegas and losing large

sums of money. He has had difficulty with relationships, particularly in the depressive swings. He has had one long-term relationship for ten years but she moved. He has had temporary jobs like tending bar and phone soliciting and has also sold marijuana on occasion for money.

13. The client states that his dad traveled and was home during weekends in his childhood. He died at age 65 in 1979. He describes his mother as "great." He has always been close with her. He states that he never "told anyone" about Janssen in order to protect his mother from shame since she is very religious. She recently moved to Santa Barbara and he talks to her frequently and lives in her house.

14. Recently, Mr. Wells has completed nursing school, really the first major accomplishment of his life, but he has not looked for a job.

15. Mr. Wells does not report sexual problems or difficulties with gender or homosexuality.

16. Mr. Wells states that his uncle doesn't realize the extent of the injury to him. He has no contact with Janssen now.

17. Mr. Wells currently reports feeling sad and energy less and "useless." He demonstrates extensive symptoms of post-traumatic stress including intrusive memories, numbing responses, flashback, problems concentrating, irritability, difficulty falling asleep and alcohol abuse. He has considered suicide but never tried. He has been extremely self-destructive and he believes that he has something wrong with him that never can be fixed. He has somatic complaints of chronic pain, stomach problems, shortness of breath and chest pains. He feels hopeless and pessimistic about his future.

18. It is my professional opinion, to a reasonable degree of psychological certainty, that the Plaintiff has manifested in the past and currently manifests symptoms consistent with Post-


Traumatic Stress Disorder, which is attributable to the sexual trauma perpetrated by Father Janssen. It is also my professional opinion that the Plaintiff has suffered with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder from the time of the abuse to the present. As a result of the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, Plaintiff suffers a significant psychological disability and impairment.

19. In addition to the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, the Plaintiff also experienced significant emotional distress when Father Janssen threatened to sue the Plaintiff and the Plaintiff's mother if the Plaintiff reported the abuse.

20. It is my professional opinion, to a reasonable degree of psychological certainty, that symptoms manifested by the Plaintiff resulted in various coping mechanisms which prevented the Plaintiff from appreciating the nature and impact of the sexual abuse. This is common with victims of sexual abuse. It is further my opinion that the passage of time to the age of majority alone would not bring about any greater ability to comprehend what happened and its impact, nor would the impact of such abuse be likely to diminish without the plaintiff receiving psychological assistance.

Should the court so request, I would be pleased to amplify any of my opinions stated herein, or to conduct an additional psychological examination to further examine these issues.

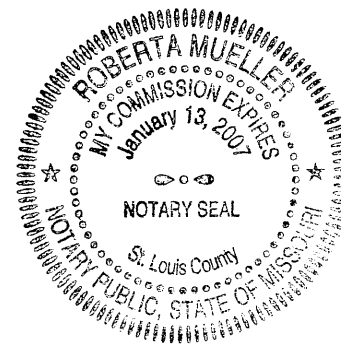
