On June 24, 1983, on p. 20
of the Commentary segment of the
Washington Times, there appeared
a book review by Allan Brownfeld
of a recent book, The Homosexual
Networks by Katherine Rueda.
In the 3rd column, the 3rd paragraph
down, there is a reference to a
consultant member of the Homosexual
networks, M. M. Bill, a group of
pederasts, who advocates the "liberation"
of the sexuality of children and the
elimination of all laws constraining
their sexuality. M. M. Bill's first
conference was held at Boston's

uttered the statements attributed

relations, between men and boys.

If the above is substantially
correct, how can such perversion,
condemned by God's Bible, be
recognized as the Catholic Church
doctrine, down thru the ages.
